- **Leeds Performance Centre at Leeds University**
- **Manchester performance Centre at Brooklands HC**

2017 is a transition year for the new Single System Player Pathway. The structure will be reviewed during this transition year so appointments are initially from November 2016 – August 31st 2017.

These are non-coaching roles, an applicant may apply for both coaching and the centre manager position but will only be appointed to one role.

The Centre Manager is expected to be an independent, non-coaching role with responsibilities to liaise and co-ordinate with the Head Coach and be a member of the Performance Centre welfare team

The Centre Manager will administer

- coaching staff, venue (including cancellation) and parents and players
- call and chair Performance Centre meetings when required
- equipment
- competitions (organisation of venue and communication with team coaches)
- co-ordinate with Academies and the Head Coach re. selection to the Performance Centre in preparation for forthcoming season (Centre managers will remain independent and have no input on selection of players)
- quality check all assessments before releasing these to the players

Qualifications required:

- Current DBS
- Current First Aid certificate
- Current Safeguarding Award

£500 for administration + £100 per day for training and home competition days

The Centre Manager is expected to attend day sessions but has no requirement to attend evening sessions
