Webmaster's Report

This season has seen more associations utilising the web system for administration and appointments. Administrating officers are more confident and able to resolve many issues. In turn they have encouraged clubs to keep on top of their information, resulting in some queries re passwords and user access rights.

SSL has been implemented for those that wanted it and the resulting security has had an impact on the webmaster's ability to resolve queries, for example resetting passwords for clubs and individuals.

Amanda Parker has been involved with scoping EH's new officiating system and companies have tendered for this and are undergoing appraisal. EH remain confident of an autumn implementation although some of the applicant businesses could not commit to this. The timing of this is unfortunate as we had to look at GDPR compliance at the same time which was costly to implement.

EH are still unsure how their new system will be financed; I gave NHUA/NHA's position as being unwilling to contribute more than we pay now, having only recently invested significant sums in the current system.

GDPR compliance remains outstanding and NHUAMC/NHA will update on this.

I end this report with the usual request that umpires, clubs and associations ensure their information is up to date before the season starts, particularly those clubs/teams having been promoted or relegated.
